Your application and documentation will be delivered to the Embassy and your case will be processed by the Embassy as soon as possible.

Please note that your application is **incomplete**. The document(s) highlighted below are missing. The Embassy therefore kindly requests you hand in the below documentation. **ALL documents must be submitted in colour:**

Missing Document (s)	Type of document
	Application form completely filled on https://applyvisa.um.dk/ , printed and signed by the applicant
	Visa Fee payment receipt printed from https://applyvisa.um.dk/
	One recent (less than six months old) passport-size photograph in color with good resemblance. (3.5cm / 4.5cm). Photoshopped pictures are forbidden and application will become inadmissible if a photoshopped picture is handed in.
	The Passport should be valid for at least three months (any other type of travel document should be valid for at least six months), beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory and with at least two blank page to affix the visa.
	Overseas travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen-countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency evacuation etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the entire duration of the trip including the date of arrival & departure.
	Flight reservations of return or round ticket . If applicant is traveling to several Schengen states proof of intra-Schengen Flight reservation, Train Itinerary or Car rental.
	Proof of Relationship <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of Marriage Certificate - In case visiting spouse living in Denmark • Certificate proving existence of family relationship; if applicant is visiting close relatives
	Invitation from host in Denmark/Iceland. The embassy recommends that the host fills in a VU2 invitation form, this form can be found on https://nyidanmark.dk/en-GB/You-want-to-apply/Short-stay-visa/Invitation-of-a-visa-applicant
	Proof of host legally residing In Denmark/Iceland <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If host is Danish/Icelandic – copy of his/ her passport • If host is an EU citizen – copy of passport/Official ID and registration in Denmark/Iceland • If host is a third country national (e.g. Indian) – copy of passport and valid residence permit <p>If the host holds an expired residence permit, but has applied for renewal, the embassy will make a decision based on the specific details of the situation.</p>
	Proof of accommodation . The host must have a permanent place to live in Denmark. (This requirement can be waived in certain cases, such as if you are a spouse, a cohabiting partner, a boyfriend or girlfriend, or minor child of a Danish national who has settled down permanently abroad and if the Danish national wishes to spend a vacation in Denmark with his/her immediate family).
	In case of minors (< 18 years) traveling: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the minor is traveling with only one parent, written consent certified by public notary of the other parent or guardian, except in cases of a parent having sole custody or guardianship of the minor. • If the minor travels alone (without parents), written consent from both parents or guardians having custody of the minor. • A photocopy of both parents' passports. If not, copies of the ID cards of the parents • A photocopy of Birth certificate <p>Note: If minor traveling with one parent. All the above documents of the other parent required.</p>
	Evidence of source of Financial support such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original private bank statement showing movements in the last three months, duly stamped and signed by the bank; • Indian income tax return acknowledgment for the last two assessment years; <p><i>If the applicant is employed:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payslips for the last three months; • Employment contract AND holiday approval/leave letter from employer <p><i>If the applicant is a company owner or self-employed:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certificate of registration of the company. <p><i>If the applicant is sponsored:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of sponsorship AND a letter from the sponsor as well as copy of the sponsor's photo ID (e.g. passport, aadhaar card or driver's license) <p><i>If the applicant is retired:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pension statements for the last three months; • Proof of regular income generated by ownership of property or business

The Embassy requests you to hand in the missing/required documentation **within 3 days from today**. If the Embassy has not received the documentation by this deadline, The Embassy will make a decision on the case based on the present information.
